Children

The Ottmanngut makes a charge of €10.00 per night for children between 0 and 4 years of age. We will be pleased to provide a baby bed. For children between 5 and 10 years of age we charge 50%, and for children between 11 and 16 years we charge 70% of the accommodation price.



Dogs

Well-behaved, house-trained dogs are welcome to stay with us. To avoid disturbing other guests, we would ask you where possible not to bring your four-legged friend into the breakfast room. We make a charge of € 20.00 a night for dogs.



Reservations

Once your reservation is confirmed we would ask you to make a prepayment of €40.00 per adult per night. Reservations will only be binding as from the date of receipt of said prepayment. We offer an early-bird discount of 5% on direct bookings of at least 3 nights made at least 120 days before the day of arrival. Where guests arrive by train or by bicycle we also offer a discount of 5% on direct bookings.



Cancellations

There is no right of withdrawal within the meaning of the consumer protection code. We nevertheless grant the following cancellation conditions: Cancellations made up to 21 days before arrival are free of charge. For cancellations made within 21 days of arrival, the prepayment will be retained as a cancellation fee. A charge of 80% of the accommodation price will be made for premature departures or late arrivals.

In order to avoid possible cancellation fees, we offer cancellation protection in the form of a fixed fee of €5.00 per person per night. This cancellation protection fee is payable in addition to the prepayment and guarantees a full refund of the pre-payment sum in the event of cancellation. You are of course also free to take out your own European travel cancellation insurance.
